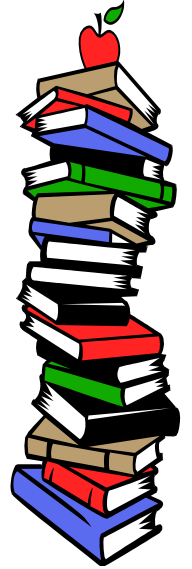
## SAFETY -Our #1 CONCERN:

In the interest of keeping our children safe, Valley View School District 365U has implemented the V-Soft Raptor visitor management system (commonly called Raptor). This internet-based program allows schools to scan valid IDs for all visitors and electronically check all visitors against registered sexual offender databases in 50 states. When you visit any VVSD school, the main office or security desk will ask for valid identification. A valid ID includes: driver's license, state ID card, military card or any foreign consulate card. During your visit, you will be given a pre-printed visitor badge to wear. You will no longer need to sign in. Upon leaving, you will return the name badge to the main office or security desk.

## *Helpful hints from the Health Room*

On November 19th, the Smile Illinois Dentists will be at KLH. Packets have already gone home in the backpack of your student. If you wish your student to see the dentist, please fill out the packet and return to the school nurse. If you do NOT want your student to see the dentist, throw away the packet. **PACKETS ARE DUE NOW.. YOU MAY BRING THEM TO TEACHER CONFERENCES ON THE 7TH and 8TH.**

If you need another packet, please call the health office at 815-372-6756.

There are many students ill with chest congestion and cough these past weeks. Please keep your student home if they are vomiting, having diarrhea, a fever over 100 without fever reducing medication, or a heavy, congested or constant cough. Once these symptoms have been gone for 24 hours, your student may return to school.
